Pouring Station Groups / Organizations will be responsible for scheduling their group to cover a pouring station for the entire weekend (Saturday, October 8 AND Sunday, October 9) of the Good Beer Festival. The group *must* provide four pourers at all times at their station. The group / organization will receive \$350 for their group. Each organization will also receive a total of 8 t-shirts and 8 festival tickets (4 per day). All pourers must be at least 18 years old to volunteer and 21 years old to receive the discounted or free admission ticket.

Please Note

- Group / Organization will need to provide a list of people who will be working at your station for the weekend. **Please include shirt sizes for each person.** There is a maximum of eight workers per day.
- Group / Organization cannot sell anything from their station during the festival.
- Group / Organization will be provided a six foot table at their station from which the group / organization may advertise and/or provide free promotional materials and/or coupons.
Promotional materials must be approved by Recreation Staff.
- Group / Organization will need to complete a Wicomico County Vendor Packet in order to be paid.
- A representative from your group / organization must attend an orientation and training session on Monday, October 3 from 6 - 7:30 p.m. at the Wicomico Youth & Civic Center Danang Rooms 1 & 2.
- Payment of \$350 will be made to organization after services are rendered. There will be no partial payments made to the organization.
- Pourers may not be intoxicated or consume alcoholic beverages during or prior to scheduled shift.
- Pourers may be dismissed at the discretion of the Pouring Supervisor and/or Recreation Staff for inappropriate behavior.
